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LIDO ISLANDER Information Sheet

The *Lido Islander* is Lido Isle's very own monthly newspaper, and is an excellent way to cost-effectively reach the highly exclusive audience of Lido Isle homeowners with your advertising message. First published in 1954, the *Lido Islander* reports on island news, activities and Lido Isle Community Association business. The tabloid-sized *Lido Islander* is a big and bold vehicle for your ad, reaching over 850 households every month in the upscale Lido Isle community.

Lido Islander Editions

The *Lido Islander* is published in two editions:

- The **print edition**, printed tabloid size, in black-and-white on glossy stock, distributed by mail to Lido Isle households and homeowners.
- The **online edition**, which is distributed in color via e-mail/PDF file to Lido Isle homeowners who have opted to receive their *Lido Islander* in this environmentally friendly manner.

Closing and Publishing Dates

The *Lido Islander* is published **on or about the first of every month**. The online edition is generally available via e-mail download link on the first of each month (or, if the first falls on a weekend, the first business day following it); the print edition is mailed via USPS Third Class Mail and may take as long as 10-14 days to arrive in residents' mailboxes.

The deadline to reserve space and to submit advertising materials is the 12th of the month preceding the issue of insertion (e.g., May 12 for the June issue). This deadline is the same for both the print and online editions. Short advertising material extensions may be granted in exceptional cases as long as an insertion order is received by the closing date, but they are not guaranteed and are generally discouraged.

Advertising

Paid advertising is accepted from qualified advertisers among the public at large who meet *Lido Islander*/LICA advertising guidelines. Ads can run in **COLOR** in the online edition at no additional charge to advertisers if color materials are provided along with black-and-white materials. Ads must conform to specified units and sizes, and prepaid discounts are available. The *Lido Islander* Advertising Information Sheet (which includes policies, rates and ad sizes) and Advertising Insertion Order Form (which includes materials requirements) provide more information on advertising in the *Lido Islander*.
